

## PALM SUNDAY APRIL 13

*Saturday Service at 5pm  
Sunday Services 8am & 10am*

The Blessing and Procession with Palm Branches begins our journey into this holy time. The Passion Gospel will be presented as we enter this week of sacred remembrance and journey through darkness to light. As Jesus entered Jerusalem in triumph, we wave our palms. As Jesus entered into the passion we walk with him through this week in prayer.

## MAUNDY THURSDAY APRIL 17

*7pm Eucharist & Foot Washing  
9pm Youth Watch & Lock-in*

This service of Holy Eucharist brings us to the Last Supper as Jesus knelt before his friends and washed their feet in an act of servanthood and love. Then as Jesus spent his last night in the Garden of Gethsemane, we will watch and pray. The Youth of our Parish will keep the all night vigil.

*(Please note the later 7pm start time this year, and we will not include the Agape supper.)*

## GOOD FRIDAY APRIL 18

*Services: 7am and 12pm (one hour services)*

The Good Friday Liturgy centers on the Passion according to John, presented by our Youth at the 7am service, and sung by our St. Paul's Choir at the noon service. We stand before the cross in Solemn Prayer, asking for mercy, pardon and peace. Communion from the Reserved Sacrament will be available at the 7am service only. Veneration of the Cross will be offered at both services for those who wish to participate.

## STATIONS OF THE CROSS

*5:30pm at St. Matthew's*

In the footsteps of Jesus we pray through the fourteen agonizing steps from the time Jesus is condemned to death to the moment his body is placed in the tomb. We will begin at St. Matthew's (404 SW 3<sup>rd</sup> Street) and walk the four tenths of a mile ending in the columbarium at St. Paul's. Beautiful icons placed along the path, will be carried to the end.

## THE GREAT VIGIL OF EASTER

*SATURDAY, APRIL 19*

*Vigil Rehearsal: 9am ✕ Service time: 7:30pm*

The Great Vigil of Easter is the most ancient of our liturgies and moves us from the darkness of the cross to the glorious and triumphant light of the resurrection. This ancient tradition meets today with the participation of all ages in the presentation of salvation history from scripture as told by story tellers (including our children) and accompanied by glorious music. As this was the service where first century seekers were baptized, we will also baptize at The Great Vigil of Easter. From children and families to elders, all will participate. Our friends from St. Matthew's will join us. Bring small bells if you have them!

## EASTER SUNDAY APRIL 20

*Service times: 7:30am, 9:30am, 11:30am*

The incredible liturgy of Easter Day will offer John's Gospel with the women finding the tomb empty until Resurrection becomes known. At the 7:30am service, hymns of Easter will be sung. At 9:30am and 11:30am, we join with the St. Paul's Choir and Guest Instrumentalists under the direction of Dr. Keith Paulson Thorp in the glorious music of Easter. The Rev. J. David Knight will preach at all services.
